Dear young cricketer,

It may only be early February, but plans are well underway to make 2010 the best ever for Youth cricket at Cumnor.

In response to our members questionnaire from 2009 we have looked at how best to organise things so that we meet our members expectations.

We will have 2 teams at both under 11 and under 13, as well as teams at under 15 and under 17. We will continue to organise Vale District Kwik Cricket for all the younger players, We will supplement the league fixtures with additional friendlies and all of this should ensure that we can offer opportunity for all of our young players to represent the club.

We also have a number of people taking ECB coaching qualifications this winter which will mean that we can further improve the coach player ratio significantly and enable a greater concentration on technical skills for all. Club captain Alastair Lee, first XI skipper Chris Mitty and Club Coach Adam Cook will oversee the development and delivery of the coaching programmes for the summer.

Training will be on Wednesday's, with those under 11 [school year 6 and below] training from 5.30 to 7.00pm, and those in school year 7 and above training from 7pm to 8.30 or later, daylight permitting. The sessions will run throughout the summer from April 21st to August 18th, 18 sessions in all. The price remains unchanged from last year at £65

The club offers unrivalled opportunity for players to progress through our youth programme into adult cricket via the Sunday 'youth development' squad and the Saturday league teams. With four Cherwell league teams playing from division 9 to the top of division 1 there is a clear route to progress to the highest levels. A number of our promising youngsters are training over the winter with the senior squads, and following nominations last summer a record number of Cumnor players are receiving coaching with the District and County squads.

We had record numbers last year and tried to accomodate everybody but we do have to limit places, so complete and return the attached application forms soon to secure your place.
